# 2017 Incoming Student Timeline

Important dates students and parents should be aware of during the financial aid process at the University of Central Florida.

- Complete the **2016-2017 FAFSA** for **Summer 2017** financial aid
- Complete the **2017-2018 FAFSA** for **Fall 2017, Spring 2018 & Summer 2018** financial aid

## January

- 2016-2017 FAFSA is available on January 1, 2016
- 2017-2018 FAFSA is available on October 1, 2016

## February

- Summer admits should complete 2016-2017 FAFSA application for summer aid
- Complete the FAFSA at [www.FAFSA.gov](http://www.FAFSA.gov) using the UCF school code: **003954**

## March

- Award letters will be mailed to all new Undergraduate students
- Financial aid awards can be viewed on students' myUCF for the upcoming academic school year
- Monitor myUCF "To Do List" and submit/complete all required financial aid items

## April

- Summer aid will be awarded to eligible students registered for summer courses
- Summer Short Term Advance Application & Textbook Purchase Program Opt-in will become available
- Update the FAFSA with tax info using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool  
*(log onto [www.FAFSA.gov](http://www.FAFSA.gov) to upload tax information to the FAFSA)*

## May

- Summer aid will begin disbursing at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of summer classes (based on Summer A, C, D term enrollment)
- Monitor myUCF "To Do List" and submit/complete all required financial aid items
- The verification priority date to submit all required financial aid items for the myUCF "To Do List" is **May 30<sup>th</sup>** for the upcoming fall semester.

## June

- June 30<sup>th</sup> is the last day to complete the FAFSA for summer aid
- If the student **has not** submit all required verification documents by the May 30<sup>th</sup> priority date, documents should be submitted no later than 60 days prior to the beginning of the fall semester

## July

- Monitor myUCF "To Do List"
- Disbursement of aid begins for Summer B term
- Summer Short Term Advance repayment due
- Students can begin accepting federal direct loans for upcoming fall & spring semesters
- Notify the financial aid office of any private scholarships for the upcoming fall semester
- Students should sign up for Direct Deposit on myUCF
- Fall Short Term Advance application available

## August

- Fall Textbook Purchase Program Opt-In begins
- Fee payment deadline is two weeks after fall classes begin
- Fall aid will begin disbursing at the beginning of the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of fall classes
